## Mixed Papers & Boxboard

✓ Newspaper, Magazines, Phone Books, Catalogues, Cereal Boxes, Office Paper, Pasta Boxes

✗ NO Styrofoam,  
NO Spoiled Paper  
(used tissue or  
paper-towel),  
NO Dirty  
Boxboard

## CLEAN Mixed Containers

✓ Milk Jugs/Cartons, Tin Food Cans, Glass Food Jars, Rigid Plastic Containers, Refundable Beverage Containers

✗ NO Plastic Bags,  
NO Plastic Film,  
NO Bubble Wrap,  
NO Lids of Any Kind,  
NO Miscellaneous Plastic



## Underneath - Bundled Corrugated Cardboard

✓ Corrugated Cardboard should be collapsed flat and placed beneath the blue bag or bundled together and placed beside the blue bag.

- All boxes MUST be collapsed.
- If you are unsure if an item is recyclable please call Ever Green Ecological Services at (780) 242-7227 BEFORE placing it at the curb.
- When in doubt - leave it out.
- In the event that any of the guidelines listed are not followed, Ever Green Ecological Services maintains the right to leave items curbside. Those items left curbside are the responsibility of the home-owner.

| x Miscellaneous Pieces of plastic/Plastic Items       | x Scrap Metal or Wood   |
| x Styrofoam   | x Food or Yard Waste  |
| x Lids (incl. tin, glass and plastic lids)            | x Soiled Paper (used Kleenex or paper towels, pizza boxes smeared with cheese, etc) |
| x Dirty Food Containers                               | x NO sharp objects, needles, blades or broken glass.                                |
| x Toxic Items (batteries, paint cans, aerosol cans)   |   |
